WINERY DEDICATES MUSICAL STAGE

ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON, JUNE 12, 2010: Thrall & Dodge Winery, the Kittitas Valley's first wine estate, has just completed its musical stage at its bonded winery at the corner of Thrall and Dodge Roads.

Thrall & Dodge Winery produces a range of varietal wines crafted from both Kittitas Valley and Yakima Valley grapes, and is the oldest producer in Kittitas County's emerging wine region. It is owned and operated by long-time resident Troy Goodreau.

"It has been in the plans to build a small stage to support musical guest. There is nothing better than to listen to some of the county's up and coming musicians and the winery supports them. "It is good to have a center of musical talent here in the valley" Troy stated. "With CWU and the arts community well embedded here it only made sense to build a stage for them to use".

So far they have had soloist piano, guitars, a bluegrass band, and even bagpipes here. Troy also said "I look forward to the summer season of seeing what kind of talent we will be able to present".

Thrall & Dodge Winery, founded in 2005, is located south of Ellensburg proper at the juncture of Thrall and Dodge Roads in the Edgemont area, long known for high-quality fruit production. At an elevation exceeding 1500 feet above sea level, the boutique wine estate enjoys a regional view looking out toward the Kittitas Valley and Mount Stuart beyond.
